22 – 24 March 2022

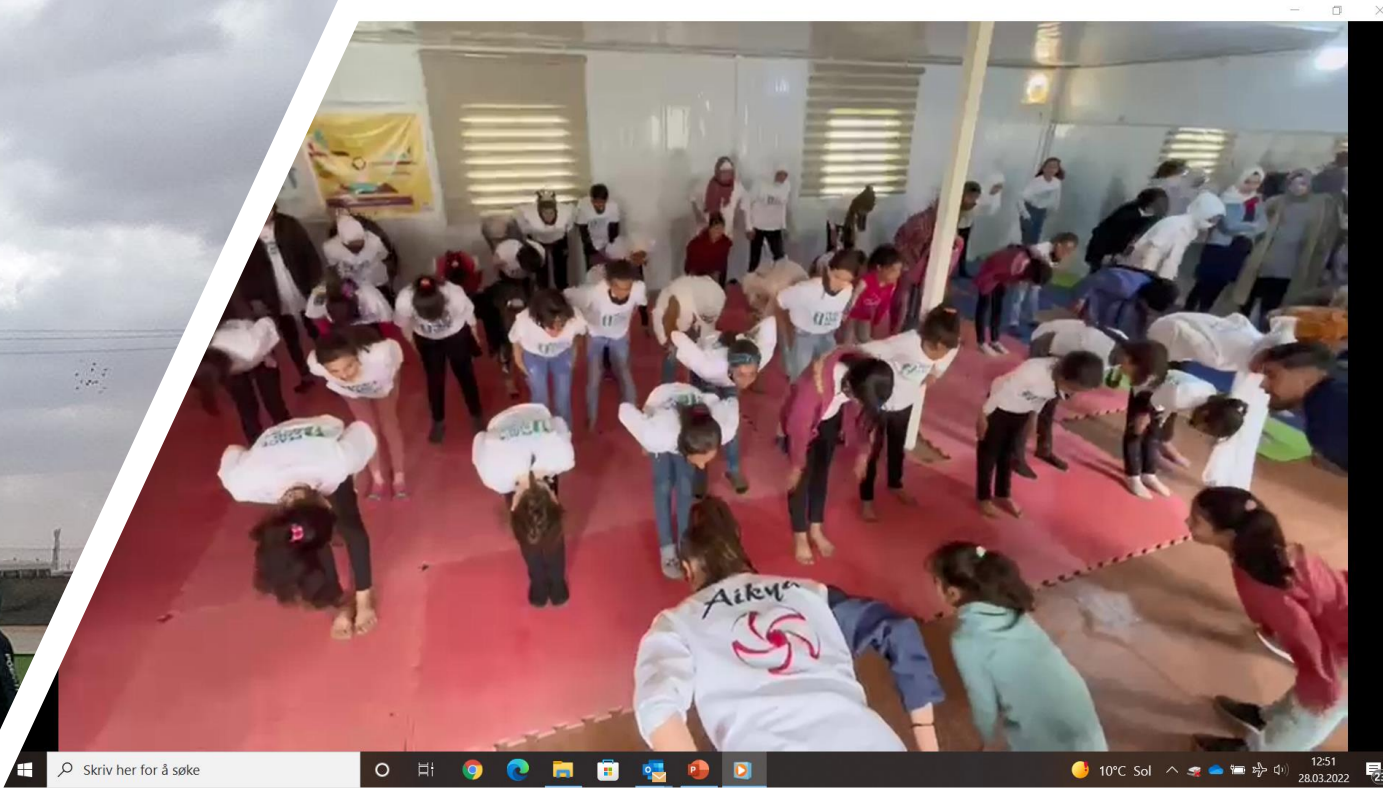
- Coaching team from Aikya Kickboxing Team from Palermo, Italy
